- If you take another “individual” class, please come Dressed in that specific costume.
Ex: HipHop classes, Contemporary, & Ballet
- Please have your child bring a change of Dance Clothes & hanging bag labeled with their name for their costume and accessories

Heymann Performing Arts Center
Tuesday, April 20th, 2021

- We are having 2 days of Stage Rehearsal (all in dance attire). Primary & Advanced Primary students will wear their uniform Sparkle tutus and all other dancers will wear ALL BLACK dance attire for rehearsals.
- **Rehearsal #1:** ALL students performing in SHOW #1
ALSO: Graduate Solos and the BALLET Production

Rehearsal #2: ALL students Performing in SHOW #2

- **We are NOT rehearsing in the Show order. I would like to get the younger dancers home as soon as possible.** Please make note...Your child's performance number will be different than the rehearsal number!! You are provided with a Rehearsal line-up & a Show line-up in this packet. Once your child has practiced her number(s), you may leave the rehearsal.
- Because of "Covid-Capacity Restrictions", all parents will drop-off their dancer at the **BackStage Door** for their rehearsal time. This is the LEFT side of the building (NOT the HOSPITAL SIDE). All parents can remain in their vehicle during this rehearsal. We have scheduled classes for 15-20 minutes on stage, but your waiting time may be 30-40 minutes. Once your dancer has finished rehearsing, you are free to leave.

Tuesday, April 20, 2021:

- **GRADUATE SOLOS:** Begin Rehearsal of Solos at **4:15 PM**
- **Primary & Adv. Primary** classes should arrive at the Heymann Performing Arts Center, no later than **4:50 pm**. Dressed in dance attire and with their dance bag.
- **If you would like to practice make-up & hair styles at this time, this is acceptable**
- We will begin Stage Rehearsal at **5:00 pm** on the Stage (beginning with the Primary A)
 - Please look at the Rehearsal schedule to figure out what time you should arrive. Each class may take about 15-20 minutes on stage. Please do not be late or you will miss your rehearsal! We cannot wait for a late arrival.
 - There will be a GUARD at the door taking Temperatures upon arrival.
 - Please send dancers wearing their MASKS
 - **STAGE MOMS WILL BE ALLOWED on Stage for these Rehearsals (Masks Required)**

Stage Rehearsals:

- Only Stage Moms and dancers are allowed to attend the Stage Rehearsal inside the theatre. Parents will DROP OFF their dancer at the BackStage Door, when their class is CALLED. There will be a DC STAFF member holding up posters with your class name when it is their time to line-up. The Heymann Center is requiring that we do things this way this year. I will need cooperation and patience from the parents as well as the dancers. Thanks for understanding.
- Please send your dancer in the proper dance attire and their dance bag with ALL necessary dance shoes
- Once your dancer has completed all of her numbers, a DC Staff member will escort them back outside for pick-up.
- **STAGE MOMS: We will need 2 stage moms per class. We have created a SIGN-UP GENIUS LINK to sign up!** The responsibility of the “Stage Mom” is to line up her designated class, 3 performances before their own and to get the class on and off of the stage. Dancers will be supervised by the Stage Moms. This year, the dancers will NOT be allowed to go into the audience until they have performed all of their numbers. Our show has many quick changes. The Stage Mom **is not responsible** for changing your dancer’s costumes, but they will watch over the class as they are lined up and waiting for their turn to dance. The parent may either stay in the dressing room with their child or return to the audience. Each parent is responsible for their own child(ren). All Stage Moms must be dressed in **dark clothing** on the night of the performance. We thank you so much, this is a very important job!
- **Stage Moms will be given a class Line-Up sheets during stage rehearsals. Please keep these sheets with you at all times. Thank you**

BACKSTAGE PASSES:

TICKETS/BACKSTAGE PASSES: Entrance & Exit will only be allowed on the Main Parking Lot side of the Heymann Center! No one is allowed to enter on the HOSPITAL sides

Each Dancer will receive a **Clear Badge/Back Stage Pass** from Dance Connection that they must PIN to their cover-up. Each “Mother” will receive a Bracelet to wear on the performance night.

Show#1 - GREEN CONFETTI bracelet

Show #2 – TURQUOISE bracelet

These bracelets are for the “Mothers/Guardian” of the dancers. This is your Back Stage Pass.

Signs will be posted to direct you to the Official Area to check in and get your Revue Ticket scanned. Once you have done this, the student dancer and Mother/Guardian will be allowed to go back & forth from the theatre to the backstage area.

- Please do not give passes to friends so they can “hang out” with your dancer! Space is limited & Covid Policies are strictly enforced. Security will be checking temperatures and backstage passes at the stage door. **Security will not let anyone enter without a pass.**
- Anyone who needs a seat in the theatre will require a ticket! A ticket holds your seat. Dancers **DO** need a ticket to enter the theatre seating during the show. If you need extra tickets, they will continue to be on sale through at the Heymann Center Box Office. **Tickets will also be sold at the Heymann Center the night of the performance, if any are available.**

Dressing Rooms

Show Day: April 22, 2021: SHOW #1 5:00 pm SHOW #2 8:00 pm

- Each CLASS will be assigned a specific dressing room or dressing area in the Ball Room. Entrance is allowed through the “Back Stage” doors or the large set of GLASS doors to enter the Ballroom dressing area. Most young dancers will be in the Ballroom. Please read the Signs to find your Class Name and your designated dressing area. Dancers/Guardians MUST wear a MASK while backstage.
See attached ballroom set-up
- You may want to bring food, snacks & activities (colors, iPads, etc.) for the performance nights. You may eat & keep all food in the dressing areas. No food is allowed in the seated theatre.
- When you arrive, you may put costumes in the assigned dressing room areas. You may want to bring a hanging rack or blanket for your dressing area. We provide tables and mirrors for you. Make sure all costumes and shoes are labeled. Be sure that your child’s costume is fitted properly! The costume should not be falling off of her shoulders or anywhere else. All headpieces must be secured! Do not leave anything in the dressing rooms after the show. Dance Connection and the Heymann Center are not responsible for lost or misplaced items.
- Only the STAGE MOMS are allowed on the SIDE of the stage. TVs are provided in the dressing areas for you to watch the show. We will also have a Picture Area set up for you to take photos. Please do not take photos in the dressing area...you may capture someone in the nude, lol!

Performance Day

- The doors will open 1 hour before the dance revue begins. Female Guardians & Dancers are ONLY allowed to Enter & Exit the theatre and backstage area on the MAIN PARKING LOT side of the building; NO access on the HOSPITAL side.
- We ask that you arrive no later than 4:15pm or 7:15pm. The Shows will begin promptly at show time.
- Quiet and order in the dressing rooms and backstage is a must! The hallways should be kept clear at all times. Running and loud talking will not be tolerated.
- **Dancers must be lined up backstage 4 numbers before their own.** This is very important in order for your child not to miss his/her number. We cannot hold a number because your child is not there. They will miss their performance, so please follow the order carefully. The shows will move very quickly this year with many quick changes between numbers.
- All parts of the costume are required. Dancers will not go on stage if they are missing a piece of their costume. No additional jewelry or nail polish allowed.
- Do not wear underwear under tights and leotards (not even thong underwear); Dance Undergarments are allowed. You may want to purchase extra tights in case of a rip or accident. No costumes of any kind allowed in the audience during the performance. Dancers must wear a cover-up with their **BACKSTAGE PASS**. Students must be completely covered with no parts of their costume exposed. Robes or long button-down shirts are the most convenient.
- Make-up must be worn and should be applied heavily due to lighting. No glitter in the hair or on the costumes.
- We must follow all rules and regulations of the Heymann Center & the State Fire Marshall.

1. Log into your Parent Portal
 - *Re-set password if needed
2. Once you are in your Portal, it will “Welcome” you to your DASHBOARD
 - Click on the “3 Lines” symbol on the Top Right of the Page & make a selection
 - ***Account** – to View your current student or Add a NEW STUDENT
 - Click on the **Blue SQUARE that says STUDENT → VIEW STUDENT**
 - **BLUE CIRCLE with PENCIL** -to edit your current student’s information -Remember to SAVE any changes
 - Please remember to enter/update student’s GRADE & YEARS of DANCE (this feature will not automatically update each year)
 - Click on the **GREEN CIRCLE with the Plus Sign** to ADD a NEW STUDENT (sibling)

You MUST Update your Student’s Profile or Add a NEW student before you can add them to any classes. Once this is done, then you may go to the next step of FINDING a CLASS

- ***Classes** – to add New classes for a new dance season
 - Click - **DASHBOARD**
 - Click – **Find Classes**
 - You will see classes listed A-Z & **Add Filter**
 - Click on **ADD FILTER**

8. When you have completed adding classes, you may Click on you **DASHBOARD** at the top of the page & View “My Schedule”. This will show you all of your Registered Dancers and their dance schedules. You may also PRINT out your schedules from this page.
9. Your 2021-2022 Enrollment is completed!

10. Please set up your **Payment Method**

- Click – **Saved Payment Methods**
- Click – **Green Circle “plus sign” to Edit or Add Card Info**
- Click - **SAVE**

11. Your 2021-2022 enrollment will be submitted to Dance Connection & viewed for approval. Once it is approved, you will receive a confirmation email and your Registration Fee will be charged to your account. If you have auto-pay, your fee will be automatically drafted. If you do not have auto-pay, you may pay our office by check or cash.

12. Tuition, Revue Fee, DVD and Costume Fees will be divided between the 9 months of dance classes (August 2021-April 2022). Once classes are added your Fees will be added to your account. These fees are paid on a monthly basis. You may reference our Tuition chart. Monthly fees are based off of how many hours a week a student takes class.

Students must have at least 3 years of ballet & jazz training & are currently enrolled in these classes at Dance Connection. They must be able to commit to an extra weekly class that will be paid for as an additional class to their regular schedule, two weekend practices per month, June classes weekly and the Bridge Training Workshop in August. Summer class tuition will apply. The Fall Elite class will be on scheduled to coordinate with their fall Regular dance class.

Class & workshop attendance is required! If a student exceeds the allotted absences or has too many other conflicting activities, they will be asked to forfeit their spot on the team.

Once we receive your sign-up notice, you will be asked to email us a photo of your dancer and we will send you a confirmation with more detailed information.

For Audition Day: please wear an ALL BLACK outfit, hair pulled back neatly and jazz shoes or ½ jazz shoes.

The dancers will be required to perform “across the floor” skills, learn a short routine and perform in small groups for our judges. The results will be posted through email and on our FaceBook page about an hour after the audition is over (audition #s only). An information letter will be emailed to the new team members.

We would like to thank you for giving your dancer this opportunity to expand their dance education. All students are welcome to attend as many conventions as they would like, regardless of team status.

**Weekly Elite Classes will be scheduled throughout the summer. We will decide this after our first meeting

INFO about Team FEES:

- This team will require 2 extra costumes at a cost of around \$150 each.
- Traveling and competing at 2 conventions, with hotel room costs & fees for convention & competition. Student tuition for a convention/competition fees: Around \$400/convention
- Team accessories: Jacket around \$100, tennis shoes \$80, new dance shoes, tights, Bag, etc.
- June, July & August dance classes/choreography – we will take monthly roll for class attendance & charge your dance account per class. Dance Choreography will be set in July and August.

****We highly recommend Elite team members sign up for MAY ACRO classes. All Elite member will begin summer classes in JUNE. ****

We will require ALL summer schedules to be turned into us in MAY. July would be a better time for vacation, since we schedule classes throughout June.

Dance Connection Senior Graduate Requirements

To be a Dance Connection Graduate that has the opportunity to perform a solo in the Spring Revue, you must have met all of the proper requirements.

- Have completed at least 2 years of Advanced Ballet as a high school student
- At least 5 years of Tap and Jazz classes
- Completed and passed ALL 4 of the Teacher Training Summer Courses at Dance Connection or a comparable program from another school
- **please see summer registration form for teacher training dates and times
- Solo Fee of \$100 due in October – Applicable Costume Fee

If you have met all of the criteria and are in good standings with your teachers, you will be considered for a graduate solo.
