

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - READ CAREFULLY

DRESS REHEARSAL ACT I Heymann Performing Arts Center Monday, April 24th, 2023

- We are having 2 Dress Rehearsals (all in costumes). Most students will attend <u>both</u> days of rehearsal (Monday & Tuesday). If you <u>only</u> have 1 number to perform, you will only come that day of rehearsal. Also, **Primary A & B** perform both of their numbers in ACT I of the show ONLY, so these classes only come to rehearsal on <u>Monday</u>, <u>April 24th</u>.
- We will be rehearsing ACT I of the show on Monday, April 24th & ACT II of the show on Tuesday, April 25th. We are NOT rehearsing in the Show order. I would like to get the younger dancers home as soon as possible. Please make note... Your child's performance number will be different than the rehearsal number!! You are provided with a Rehearsal line-up & a Show line-up in this packet. Once your child has practiced his/her number(s), you may leave the rehearsal.

Monday, April 24th, 2023:

- GRADUATE SOLOs: Begin Rehearsal of Solos at 4:00 PM
- **Primary & Adv. Primary** classes should arrive at the Heymann Performing Arts Center, no later than **4:50 pm**. Dressed in your costume with hair and make-up.
- We will begin Dress Rehearsal at **5:00 pm** on the Stage (beginning with the Primary A & B classes)
 - Please look at the Rehearsal schedule to figure out what time you should arrive. I cannot give you an exact timeline. Each class may take about 10 minutes on stage. Please do not be late or you will miss your rehearsal! We cannot wait for a late arrival.
 - Once your class is finished rehearsals, we ask that you leave the theatre. The Heymann Center has an occupancy set for our school during dress rehearsals.
 - While in the theatre, please sit with your class in the designated areas. This helps with our organization. No food is allowed in the theatre. No one is allowed in <u>Balcony area!</u>
 - **Dressing Areas**: On Monday & Tuesday, we will only have access to the backstage "Star" dressing rooms & restrooms. A large set of restrooms are located in the front lobby area of the Heymann Center. For the Show#1-Wednesday & Show#2-Thursday, we will have specific dressing areas for EVERY CLASS Backstage (in the Ballroom & Star Dressing Rooms)

- Tuesday, April 25th, 2023: Arrive at the Heymann Performing Arts Center, no later than 4:50pm.
- AWARD PRESENTATION line-up will begin at 5:00 pm on STAGE. If you are receiving a Yearly award &/or Perfect Attendance (not 1st or 2nd year certificates), you will line up in the Yearly award line. There will be a separate line-up for Perfect Attendance Only. It is very important that you DROP off your child with one of the teachers at the backstage door (LEFT side of Building NOT the hospital side; near vending machines), then return to your seat in the audience.
 - Students will be dressed in their costume for the awards presentation. If your child Does NOT have dress rehearsal this day, they may wear jeans and their "Dance Revue" t-shirt or another Dance Connection shirt.
- We will be handing out the AWARDs at the Studio, the last week of classes! It will be your responsibility to <u>bring your award with you on Tuesday</u>. If you forget, it's no big deal...your student will be recognized on stage for his/her accomplishments!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ALL STUDENTS MUST BE PRESENT AT THE DRESS REHEARSAL IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE REVUE!!!!!

Stage Rehearsals:

- Only 1 parent (guardian) & dancers are allowed to attend the Dress Rehearsal. Please do not bring other family members or friends to rehearsal. If we have too many people, the Heymann center will require us use a ticketing system for dress rehearsals, by law of the fire marshal. I will need cooperation and patience from the parents as well as the dancers. Thanks for understanding.
- Students must sit quietly in the auditorium while other classes are on stage. Loud talking and running will not be tolerated. No one is allowed in the balcony area during the rehearsals. Please DO NOT cross over, "taped off" areas. All food must be eaten "outside" of the theatre area.
- Picture taking and video cameras <u>are allowed for the dress rehearsal only</u>. Please DO NOT post any dances on social media sites before the dance revues. No cameras or video cameras are allowed inside the auditorium on the night of the performance. A professional videographer will be recording both shows for our DVD.
 - All PARENT PORTAL Pre-Registrations must be submitted & outstanding bills are due by <u>Thursday</u>, <u>April 21st</u>, <u>2023</u>. Your student will not be able to participate unless all of your payments are current and up to date.
- STAGE MOMS: We will need 2 stage moms per class. We have created a SIGN-UP GENIUS LINK to sign up! The responsibility of the "Stage Mom" is to line up her designated class, 3 performances before their own and to get the class on & off the stage. Dancers will be supervised by the Stage Moms. Our show has many quick changes. The Stage Mom is not responsible for changing your dancer's costumes, but they will watch over the class as they are lined up and waiting for their turn to dance. The parent may either stay in the dressing room with their child or return to the audience. Once your child has performed, please return to the dressing room to claim your child. Each parent is responsible for their own child(ren). All Stage Moms must be dressed in dark clothing on the night of the performance. We thank you so much, this is a very important job!
- Stage Moms will be given a class Line-Up sheets during stage rehearsals. Please keep these sheets with you at all times. Thank you

BACKSTAGE PASSES:

TICKETS/BACKSTAGE PASSES: Entrance & Exit will only be allowed on the Main Parking Lot - LEFT side of the Heymann Center! No one is allowed to enter on the HOSPITAL sides

Each Dancer will receive a **Clear Badge/Back Stage Pass** from Dance Connection that they must PIN to their cover-up. Each "Mother" will receive a Bracelet to wear on the performance night.

Show#1 - WEDNESDAY bracelet - RED

Show #2 – THURSDAY bracelet - BLUE

These bracelets are for the "Mothers/Guardian" of the dancers. This is your Back Stage Pass.

Signs will be posted to direct you to the Official Area to check in and get your Revue Ticket scanned. Once you have done this, the student dancer and Mother/Guardian will be allowed to go back & forth from the theatre to the backstage area.

- Please do not give passes to friends so they can "hang out" with your dancer! Space is limited. **Security** will not let anyone enter without a pass.
- Anyone who needs a seat in the theatre will require a ticket! A ticket holds your seat. Dancers DO need a ticket to enter the theatre seating during the show. If you need extra tickets, they will continue to be on sale through at the Heymann Center Box Office. Tickets will also be sold at the Heymann Center the night of the performance, if any are available.

DANCING PARENTS:

*BEGINNER A & B: Packets will contain I extra TURQUOISE Bracelet for the Dance DAD, for all the "DADs" that will be dancing with their daughters. "DADs" must wear their bracelet on their LEFT wrist, the night of their performance as well as scan their ticket and report to their designated Back Stage Area near the vending machines. We will REMOVE the Bracelet before the dance! A designated "teacher" will walk all "Dance Dads" to their designated waiting area.

*Dance Dad's will meet at the BackStage Area (near vending machines) before the show begins – around 6pm



**Tight Rope is #3 ACT1 in the Show#1 & #2. "DAD" dancers Must report to backstage before the show begins...during Senior Graduate Awards.

Dressing Rooms

• <u>Dress Rehearsal Days</u>: We **will not** have the Ballroom Dressing area available on Dress Rehearsal days. Your child should come to Dress Rehearsal dressed in their appropriate costume. Some students may need to change in the "STAR Dressing Rooms" or the Restrooms. Once your child has finished all of his/her numbers, you may leave the rehearsal.

Show Days: SHOW #1 Wed, April 26th 6:00pm SHOW #2 Thurs, April 27th 6:00pm

• Each CLASS will be assigned a specific dressing room or dressing area in the Ball Room. Entrance is allowed through the "Back Stage" doors or the large set of GLASS doors to enter the Ballroom dressing area. Most young dancers will be in the Ballroom. Please read the Signs to find your Class Name and your designated dressing area.

- There is also a specific <u>MALE dressing room</u> for our male dancers. Please read the Signs to find your designated dressing area.
- You may want to bring food, snacks & activities (colors, iPads, etc.) for the performance nights. You may eat & keep all food in the dressing areas. No food is allowed in the seated theatre.
- When you arrive, you may put costumes in the assigned dressing room areas. You may want to bring a hanging rack or blanket for your dressing area. We provide tables and mirrors for you. Make sure all costumes and shoes are labeled. Be sure that your child's costume is fitted properly! The costume should not be falling off of her shoulders or anywhere else. All headpieces must be secured! Do not leave anything in the dressing rooms after the show. Dance Connection and the Heymann Center are not responsible for lost or misplaced items.
- Only the STAGE MOMS are allowed on the SIDE of the stage. TVs are provided in the dressing areas for you to watch the show. We will also have a Picture Area set up for you to take photos. Please do not take photos in the dressing area...you may capture someone in the nude, lol!

Performance Day

- The doors will open 1 hour before the dance revue begins. Female Guardians & Dancers are ONLY allowed to Enter & Exit the theatre and backstage area on the MAIN PARKING LOT side of the building; NO access on the HOSPITAL side.
- We ask that you arrive no later than 5:30pm. The Graduate presentation begins at 6pm and the show begins promptly at 6:30pm.
- Quiet and order in the dressing rooms and backstage is a must! The hallways should be kept clear at all times. Running and loud talking will not be tolerated.
- Dancers must be lined up backstage 3-4 numbers before their own. This is very important for your child not to miss his/her number. We cannot hold a number because your child is not there. They will miss their performance, so please follow the order carefully.
- All parts of the costume are required. Dancers will not go on stage if they are missing a piece of their costume. No additional jewelry or nail polish allowed.
- Do not wear underwear under tights and leotards (not even thong underwear). You may want to purchase extra tights in case of a rip or accident. No costumes of any kind allowed in the audience during the performance. Dancers must wear a cover-up with their **BACKSTAGE PASS**. Students must be completely covered with no parts of their costume exposed. Robes or long button-down shirts are the most convenient.
- Make-up must be worn and should be applied heavily due to lighting. No glitter in the hair or on the costumes
- We must follow all rules and regulations of the Heymann Center & the State Fire Marshall.

- 11. Your 2023-2024 enrollment will be submitted to Dance Connection & viewed for approval. Once it is approved, you will receive a confirmation email and your Registration Fee will be charged to your account. If you have auto-pay, your fee will be automatically drafted. If you do not have auto-pay, you may pay our office by check or cash.
- 12. Tuition, Revue Fee, DVD and Costume Fees will be divided between the 9 months of dance classes (August 2023-April 2024). Once classes are added your Fees will be added to your account. These fees are paid on a monthly basis. You may reference our Tuition chart. Monthly fees are based off of how many hours a week a student takes class. All costumes are added and divided by the 9 months also.

Dance Connection Elite Competition Team Audition Thursday, May 11th, 2023 Ages 8 & Up: 4:30pm-7:30 pm <u>Audition Fee: \$50</u>

Students must have at least 3 years of ballet & jazz training & are currently enrolled in these classes at Dance Connection. They must be able to commit to an extra weekly class that will be paid for as an additional class to their regular schedule, two weekend practices per month & June & July classes weekly. - Solo Choreography/Teaching Fee of \$500 due in October Applicable Costume Fee & Rehearsal Fees will be applied

If you have met all the criteria and are in good standings with your teachers, you will be considered for a graduate solo.

All graduating Seniors will be recognized as a "Graduate" on stage at the Spring Revue, regardless of if they are performing a solo or not.
